EAGLES NOTES

- **DOUG PEDERSON** was KC offensive coordinator from 2013-15.
- **QB CARSON WENTZ** completed 26 of 39 (66.7 pct.) for 307 yards, 2 TDs & 1 INT for 96.8 rating in Week 1. Has 5 career 300-yard games. Is 4-0 in career in Sept. games.
- **RB LE GARRETTE BLOUNT** had rec. TD in Phi. debut last week, 2nd career TD catch. **RB DARREN SPROLES** had 5 catches for 43 yards in Week 1. Is only player in NFL history with 30+ rec. TDs (30), 20+ rush TDs (22), PR-TD (7) & KR-TD (2).
- WR NELSON AGHOLOR had career-high 6 receptions for 86 yards, incl. 58-yard TD last week. Has TD in 2 of past 3. In past 4 vs. AFC, WR ALSHON JEFFERY has 26 receptions for 426 yards (106.5 per game). TE ZACH ERTZ led team with 8 receptions & 93 rec. yards in Week 1. Aims for 5th in row vs. AFC with 5+ catches. TE BRENT CELEK had 8 receptions for 104 yards & TD in 9/27/09 meeting.
- DE BRANDON GRAHAM had 2 sacks & FF in Week

 3rd career game with 2+ sacks & FF. Had sack in last
 meeting. DT FLETCHER COX had sack, FF & 20-yard
 FR-TD last week. Has 5 sacks & FF in past 5 vs. AFC. DT
 TIMMY JERNIGAN had sack last week in Phi. debut. Tied
 career-high in tackles (6) in last meeting (12/20/15 with Bal.).
 LB JORDAN HICKS has 18 tackles & 2 INTs in 3 career
 road games vs. AFC. CB JALEN MILLS led team with 9

CHIEFS NOTES

- CHIEFS had 537 total net yards (352 pass, 185 rush) in Week 1, most by KC since 1/1/06 vs. Cin.
- ANDY REID was Phi. head coach from 1999-2012 & had 130-93-1 (.583) record. Led Eagles to 5 NFC Championship Games.
- **QB ALEX SMITH** completed 28 of 35 passes (80.0 pct.) for 368 yards with 4 TDs vs. 0 INTs for 148.6 rating last week. Was 1st QB since 1950 with 2 TD passes of 75+ yards on KO Weekend. Has 873 pass yards (291 per game) with 5 TDs vs. 2 INTs in past 3 vs. Phi.
- **RB KAREEM HUNT** (rookie) had 246 scrimmage yards (148 rush, 98 rec.), most all-time by player in NFL debut, & 3 total TDs (1 rush, 2 rec.) in Week 1. **RB CHARCANDRICK WEST** had rush TD last week.
- WR TYREEK HILL has 60+ yard TD in 5 consecutive games, longest streak in NFL history. Had career-high 133 rec. yards last week, incl. 75-yard TD. Has 13 total TDs (7 rec., 3 rush, 2 PR, 1 KR) since 2016. TE TRAVIS KELCE has 2,040 rec. yards since 2015, 2nd most among NFL TEs. TE DEMETRIUS HARRIS had TD catch in Week 1.
- LB JUSTIN HOUSTON had 2 sacks last week. Has 18 1.5+ sack games since entering NFL in 2011, 2nd most in league. Had career-high 4.5 sacks, 3 PD, FF & 2 FRs in last meeting. LB DEE FORD had FF last week. DT BENNIE LOGAN was 3rd round draft pick of Phi. in 2013. Is 1 of 9 DTs since 2013 with 25+ TFL (27) & 3+ FFs (3). CB MARCUS PETERS has 14 INTs since 2015, most in NFL.
