RAIDERS NOTES

- **QB DEREK CARR** will make 50th career start. Needs 4 TDs to become 5th QB in NFL history with 90 TD passes in 1st 50 games. Completed 23 of 28 (82.1 pct.) for 230 yards with 3 TDs vs. 0 INTs for 136.6 rating last week. Has 8 pass TDs vs. 0 INTs with 125.0 rating in past 3. In past 5 vs. NFC, has 1,722 pass yards (344.4 per game) with 12 TDs vs. 3 INTs for 99.8 rating.
- **RB MARSHAWN LYNCH** had rush TD last week. In 2 career meetings, has 248 scrimmage yards (183 rush, 65 rec.) & 2 TD catches. Has 75 rush TDs since entering league in 2007, 2nd most in NFL. **RB JALEN RICHARD** had 52-yard TD run in Week 2.
- **WR MICHAEL CRABTREE** had 80 rec. yards & 3 TD catches last week, his 2nd career 3 TD game (10/2/16 at Bal.). Has 20 TD catches since 2015, tied for 4th most in NFL. Aims for 3rd in row with 6+ catches & 80+ rec. yards. **WR AMARI COOPER** has 523 rec. yards (104.6 per game) & 3 TD catches in past 5 vs. NFC. Has 135+ rec. yards in each of past 2 on road vs. NFC. **TE JARED COOK** had 105 rec. yards & TD in last meeting (11/20/16 with GB). Has 3 TD catches in past 3 meetings.
- **DE KHALIL MACK** had sack last week. In past 9 vs. NFC, has 8 sacks, 2 FFs, FR & INT-TD. Has 27 sacks since 2015, most in NFL. **S REGGIE NELSON** has 35 INTs since entering NFL in 2007, most among active players. **DE MARIO EDWARDS, JR.** has 2 sacks in past 2.

REDSKINS NOTES

- **QB KIRK COUSINS** passed for TD & had 97.6 rating last week. In past 5 vs. AFC, has 1,549 pass yards (309.8 per game) with 10 TDs & 5 INTs for 101.4 rating. Since 2015, ranks 3rd in NFC in comp. (826) & 4th in pass yards (9,502).
- **RB CHRIS THOMPSON** had 106 scrimmage yards (career-high 77 rush, 29 rec.) & 2 TDs in Week 2. Has 5 TDs (3 rush, 2 rec.) in past 4. **RB ROB KELLEY** led team with 78 rush yards last week. Has 4 rush TDs in past 4 at home. Rookie **RB SAMAJE PERINE** rushed for 67 yards in Week 2.
- **TE JORDAN REED** has 30 catches for 284 yards (71 per game) & 5 TDs in past 4 at home vs. AFC. Since 2015, leads NFC TEs with 17 TD catches. **WR JAMISON CROWDER** has 4 rec. TDs in past 8 at home. **WR RYAN GRANT** had rec. TD last week.
- **LB RYAN KERRIGAN** had sack & FF in Week 2. Has 8.5 sacks, 2 FFs & INT in past 11 at home. Had 2 sacks & FF in last meeting. Since 2013, is only NFL LB with 40+ sacks (44) & 14+ FFs (14). **LB PRESTON SMITH** aims for 3rd in row with sack. **LB MASON FOSTER** had INT last week. Has 65 tackles (10.8 per game) in past 6. **CB JOSH NORMAN** had career-high 2 FFs in Week 2. Has 5 PD in past 3 at home. Since 2014, leads NFL with 51 PD. **LB ZACH BROWN** led team with 10 tackles last week. Has 18 tackles & INT in 3 career meetings.
