The Buffalo Bills will take on the Kansas City Chiefs in their second straight game on the road on Sunday at Arrowhead Stadium. Kickoff is scheduled to take place at 1:00 p.m. ET. Sunday's game will be the 45th regular season meeting between Buffalo and Kansas City, with the Bills holding a 23-20-1 advantage in the series.

- Bills Defensive Coordinator Leslie Frazier (1999-2002), Offensive Line Coach Juan Castillo (1995-2013), Quarterbacks Coach **David Culley** (1999-2012) and Chiefs Assistant Head Coach Brad Childress (1999-2005), Offensive Coordinator Matt Nagy (2008-12), Assistant Quarterbacks Coach Corey Matthaei (2006-12), Tight Ends Coach Tom Melvin (1999-2012), Special Teams Coordinator Dave Toub (2001-03) and Strength and Conditioning Coach Barry Rubin (2008-12) all worked on Reid's coaching staff with the Eagles.

- Kansas City LB Reggie Ragland was a member of the Bills organization in 2016 and on the 2017 preseason roster. The Bills traded Ragland to the Chiefs on August 28 in exchange for 2019 fourth-round draft pick.
- Bills FB Patrick DiMarco spent the 2012 season with the Chiefs. DiMarco led the way for Jamaal Charles, who rushed for a career-high 1,509 yards that season.
